In this stage of the project you return to the archive you've assembled and add the following:

1. Two additional sources
2. A 300 word description of each of your sources. In your descriptions you should identify the source and its origin. In addition, you should provide an analysis of the information that the source offers about your research site during the colonial period. In your analysis, you should engage with the different methodologies and tools we've discussed this semester to recover traces and fragments of forgotten lives by reading against the grain, along the bias, exposing the silences, and other methods that offer new ways to analyze sources.
3. A historical map from the NYPL digital map collection related to your site that you will use for the final project. (<https://digitalcollections.nypl.org/collections/maps-of-new-york-city-and-state#/?tab=navigation>)
